Academic Policy

Full Time or Part Time Schooling Options:

Please note: All students are automatically enrolled in our Wednesday afternoon Bible classes as part of their required instruction.

K-6th Elementary Students:

These students have the option of attending full time or part time.

Our elementary students all enroll in our Section A morning classes (M, T, W, Th) and our Bible Class (Wednesday afternoon). They may additionally enroll in section B afternoon classes.

Section A morning classes cover all math and English requirements, including math labs, grammar, spelling, vocabulary, writing and reading. Section B afternoon classes cover science, social studies and all electives such as art, PE, music, library, drama, etc. (Families who choose the part-time option, will be responsible to cover all state requirements on their own.)

All families also agree to participate in corporate prayer 2 hours per week (with at least one parent) in one of the local prayer rooms including IHOP-KC, YWAM, or other church prayer meetings.

Junior High Students:

These students have the option of attending full time or part time.

Our junior high students must enroll in Section A morning classes (M, T, W, Th) and our Bible class (Wednesday afternoon). They may additionally enroll in Section B afternoon classes.

All students also agree to participate in corporate prayer 2 hours per week (with at least one parent) in one of the local prayer rooms including IHOP-KC, YWAM, or other church prayer meetings.

Senior High Students:

Senior high students will take a four-year sequence of classes that fulfill (and exceed) the Missouri state graduation requirements. For seniors, we also offer a tailor-made internship program for them. And our Daniel Track class which includes teaching on Biblical Worldview, Leadership and Excellence, and Old and New Testament Surveys, will meet on Wednesday afternoons.

We also offer an opportunity for homeschooling students to join in up to three classes of their choosing.
