

K -6th Elementary Class Descriptions

Students will automatically be enrolled in Section A and Bible (part time) and maybe add Section B (for full time). Each grade level will meet individually. All families are required to spend 2 hours/week minimum in the prayer room.

FULL TIME: Section A, B and Bible - \$3,050/ year

PART TIME: Sections A and Bible only - \$1,980/ year

Elementary supply fees (for all projects, materials, games, Parent Alert, activity fee for field trips, etc) - \$325/year

Book fee - \$150/year (Please note that all consumable books will be order and billed through TDA. Non-consumable books will be rented to families.)

SECTION A CLASSES plus Bible (Wed afternoons):

Mornings plus Bible 8am – 12:30pm

Prerequisites: passing grade level Math and Language Arts tests from the past year.

All students will automatically be enrolled in this section.

Mathematics and Math Lab: Students will take grade appropriate math, learning concepts, working with manipulatives and games, and doing homework problems together in math lab. Concept mastery and memorization will be a strong focus.

Language Arts and Language Arts Lab: Students will study a grade appropriate ABeka Language Arts program which will include reading, spelling, vocabulary, writing and grammar. Books will also be chosen that coincide with history and science studies as well. Concept mastery and memorization will be a strong focus.

BIBLE CLASS: All students are automatically enrolled in Bible as part of the required curriculum (on Wednesday afternoons).

Wednesday afternoon – 1:00-3:00pm

Students will learn Bible stories and truths and build upon those year after year. Our own TDA curriculum is geared towards planting these truths in students' hearts through prayer, Scripture memory, waiting on the Lord, singing the Word and meditation. Centers for hands-on learning and prayer over each other area also included.

SECTION B CLASSES:

Afternoons 12:3-3:00pm

Science, Social Studies, Geography, Library and Electives: Students will study grade appropriate science, social studies and geography focusing on sequential learning and discovery. Hands-on projects and presentations will also help students learn and grow in their knowledge of the world around them. Each quarter will also have an added semester electives for exposure and enrichment including subjects like art, choir, conversational language and PE.
